Current Cases in Humboldt County

- 27 total confirmed cases
 - 6 new cases yesterday
 - 3 cases of which were community transmission
 - 26 active cases
 - 1 recovered case
 - 1 case is hospitalized

Current Cases in Hoopa, CA

- 0 Positive cases
- 7 patients have been tested
 - All seven tests came back negative

 - Please call (530) 625-8100
 - Orders placed before 3 PM will have same-day delivery
 - If supplies are in stock.
 - Order must be over \$20. Cash or check only.
- Preferred elder's shopping hours are 6 AM - 8 AM.

Hoopa Grocery Store

- Limit to 1 package of toilet paper, 1 case of water, and 1 hand sanitizer per customer.
 - Toilet paper is out of stock but the staff is regularly seeking new supplies.

- Occupancy is limited to 10 shoppers in the store.
 - After 2 people exit the store they will allow 2 people in.

Hoopa Mini Mart

- Occupancy is limited to 3 shoppers in the store.
- Gas is pumped by the staff.
- Preferred payment method debit/credit card.
