Current Cases in Humboldt County

- 28 total confirmed cases
- 27 total active cases
 - 13 of cases had contact with a known case
 - 8 of cases had traveled internationally
 - 3 of the cases were community transmission
- 1 additional case as of yesterday
- 1 case was hospitalized
- 1 case recovered

These case numbers were retrieved from the Humboldt County [website](#).

Humboldt County has been releasing information after 5 PM, and this report was created before 5 PM.

Current Cases in Hoopa, CA

- 0 Positive cases
- 7 patients have been tested
 - All seven tests came back negative
- 5 pending tests as of today

COVID-19 Response Team Update

Updates from our team:

- We are highly encouraging people to stay home unless people need to do essential travel for things like food, medicine, mail, or other necessary items.
 - If you need to travel for any reason, please [practice social distancing](#) and maintain approximately six (6) feet away from other people.
 - If you are sick, we want to emphasize that people need to [wear facemasks](#) when they're around other people or in a healthcare provider's office.
 - Please also clean your hands often either by using soap and water for over 20 seconds or use [hand sanitizer](#) with over 60 percent alcohol.
- Yesterday we met with Humboldt County, Del Norte County, and the River Tribes to help in collaboration efforts.
- As of earlier this week, we have received additional food for the food bank.
- We have started a podcast, please search on your favorite player.
- Please connect with us in order to identify essential items to discourage trips to town.

 - Please call (530) 625-8100
 - Orders placed before 3 PM will have same-day delivery if supplies are in stock.
 - Order must be over \$20. Cash or check only.
- Preferred elder's shopping hours are 6 AM - 8 AM.

TCCC

- Will be delivering a food box to **ALL COMMUNITY ELDERS** (ages 65 and over) in the next several days.

Firewood

- A free 1/2 cord of firewood can be ordered for community elders (ages 65 and over) in the community

Community Updates

Hoopa Grocery Store

- Limit to 1 package of toilet paper, 1 case of water, and 1 hand sanitizer per customer.
 - Toilet paper is out of stock, but the staff is regularly seeking new supplies.
- Occupancy is limited to 10 shoppers in the store.
 - After 2 people exit the store, they will allow 2 people in.

Hoopa Mini Mart

- Occupancy is limited to 3 shoppers in the store.
- Gas is pumped by the staff.
- Preferred payment method debit/credit card.
