#### Current cases in Humboldt County

- Total confirmed positive cases: **52** (+0 since last report)
- Total Recovered cases: **50** (+0 since last report)
- Total tests conducted: **1,853** (+53 since last report)
- Percentage of tests returned positive: **2.80%**

#### Current cases at K'ima:w Medical Center

- Total tests conducted: **44** (+6 since the last report)
- Total confirmed positive cases: **1** (+0 since last report)
- Percentage of tests returned positive: **2.27%**

K'ima:w Medical Center now has the ability to conduct rapid testing for COVID-19 and will have results in less than 15 minutes. That being said, testing supplies are limited. If you believe you need to be tested then please call **(530) 625-4261 extension 0218**.

#### COVID-19 Response Team Update

- Current operation level: 2
- Stay-at-Home order is active in Hoopa, CA due to COVID-19 Pandemic
  - Curfew is currently in effect from 8 PM to 4 AM every day.
    - The Hoopa OES COVID-19 response team is currently working on reducing the curfew hours. As of Monday, April 27, the new curfew hours will be 10 pm to 4 am every day.
- A free food box will be available to ALL Hoopa Residents **on April 28th, 29th, and 30th**. Limit one (1) per household.
  - Pick up Time: 12 PM to 4 PM
  - Locations:
    - 1) Tsemeta Forest Nursery, 503 Marshall Ln.
    - 2) Hoopa Fire Station, 11121 State Hwy 96
    - 3) Hoopa Modular Plant, 61 Calpac Rd.
      - \*Please go to the closest location to you.
      - Note: Delivery is available ONLY for those who cannot otherwise make it to the distribution point. To schedule, please call or text (530) 625-8100.
- If any **Hoopa Tribal workers** need help applying for unemployment benefits, please contact the Hoopa Human Resources Department at **530-625-9200**.

- If anyone local needs help to apply for Stimulus Checks online, please *make an appointment* at the Hoopa TANF Resource Center at **530-625-4816**.
- Limiting access to our local residents only in Hoopa, CA.
- Status of Tribal Roads:
  - We are adding signs on all tribal roads stating, "Health Crisis, Local Traffic Only"
  - Hard road closures - K-Rails or gates have been placed on the following roads:
    - Hopkins C on Mill Creek, Pine Creek below Burnt Ranch Prairies, and Deer Horn road just past McCovey Prairie
  - Restricted to Emergency Travel Only on:
    - Bair Road and Dowd Road

#### **Groceries**

##### **Hoopa Grocery Store**

- Delivery available Monday through Friday to **ALL COMMUNITY ELDERS** (ages 65 and over) for groceries.
  - Please call the Hoopa Grocery Store at **(530) 625-1013**
  - Orders placed before 3 PM will have same-day delivery if supplies are in stock.
  - Orders must be over \$20, through cash or check only.
- Preferred elder's shopping hours are 6 AM - 8 AM.

##### **Firewood**

- A free 1/2 cord of firewood can be ordered for community elders (ages 65 and over)

### **Community Updates**

#### **Hoopa Grocery Store**

- Open from **6 AM to 7 PM**
- They have assigned an employee dedicated to sanitizing the store full time

RE: Morning Report: April 24, 2020

- Limit to 1 package of toilet paper, 1 case of water, and 1 hand sanitizer per customer.
- Occupancy is limited to 10 shoppers in the store.
  - After 2 people exit the store, they will allow 2 people in.

#### **Hoopla Mini Mart**

- Open, without limited hours, from **7 AM to 7 PM**
- They implemented a **\$5 minimum** purchase
- Occupancy is limited to 3 people
- Gas is pumped by the staff, and the preferred payment method is debit/credit card.

#### **Coast Central Credit Union**

- Hours have changed to 9:30 AM to 2:30 PM

#### **Hoopla Valley PUD**

- The Hoopla Valley PUD District Office is open Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 8 AM to 12 PM
- The Transfer Station is open from 9 AM to 5 PM on Friday through Tuesday.

#### **Forestry**

- If you need to purchase firewood, please call **(530) 625-8100**.

#### **K'ima:w Medical Center**

- Requests that you call in before you visit at **(530) 625-4261** so that they can prepare for your visit properly.
- The K'ima:w Medical Center Pharmacy has changed its closing time to 5 PM.

#### **Hoopla Fire Department**

- Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, burn permits will not be issued.
  - Please continue to use 2019 Burn permits.

#### **Humboldt County**

- The County has recently limited the types of services in operation, and the list can be found on the Hoopla OES website.
- The County is also requiring people to wear facial coverings in specific settings, effective on Friday, April 24th, 2020 at 12:01 AM.
  - This County [Health Order](#) states people must wear a facial covering before they enter:
    - Any indoor facility except for their own residence
    - Any enclosed space
    - Any outdoor space where individuals are unable to maintain at all times a distance of six feet from others.
  - The Hoopla Valley Reservation also has an order that highly mirrors the above County's Health Order on facial coverings effective on Friday, April 24th, 2020 at 11:59 PM.
